

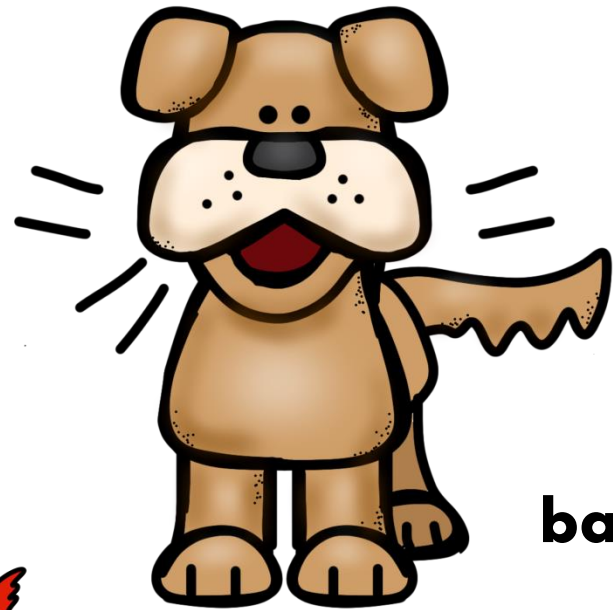
A verb is a part of speech that shows the occurrence or performance of an action, the existence of a state or condition, etc.

bark



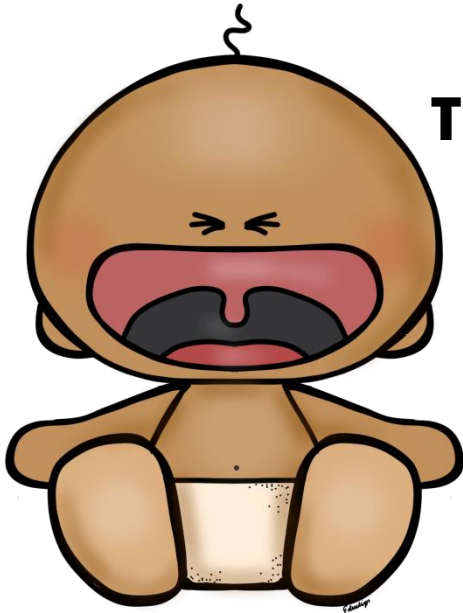

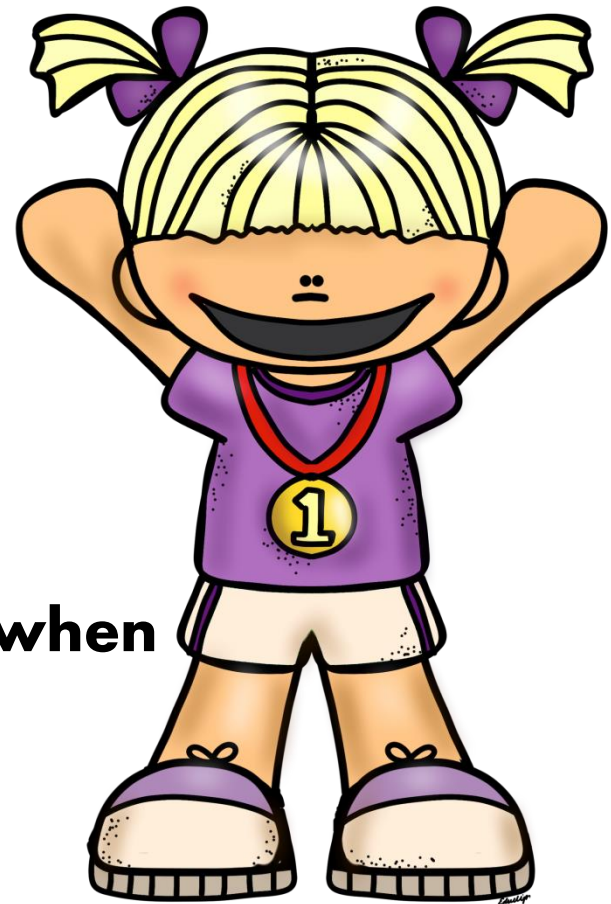

[connect the subject to a noun or adjective that helps in describing or providing additional information about the subject]



The baby **is** hungry.



Megan **was** happy when she won the race.

[used to indicate that something is probable or possible]

It is a clear night.

It must be cold.

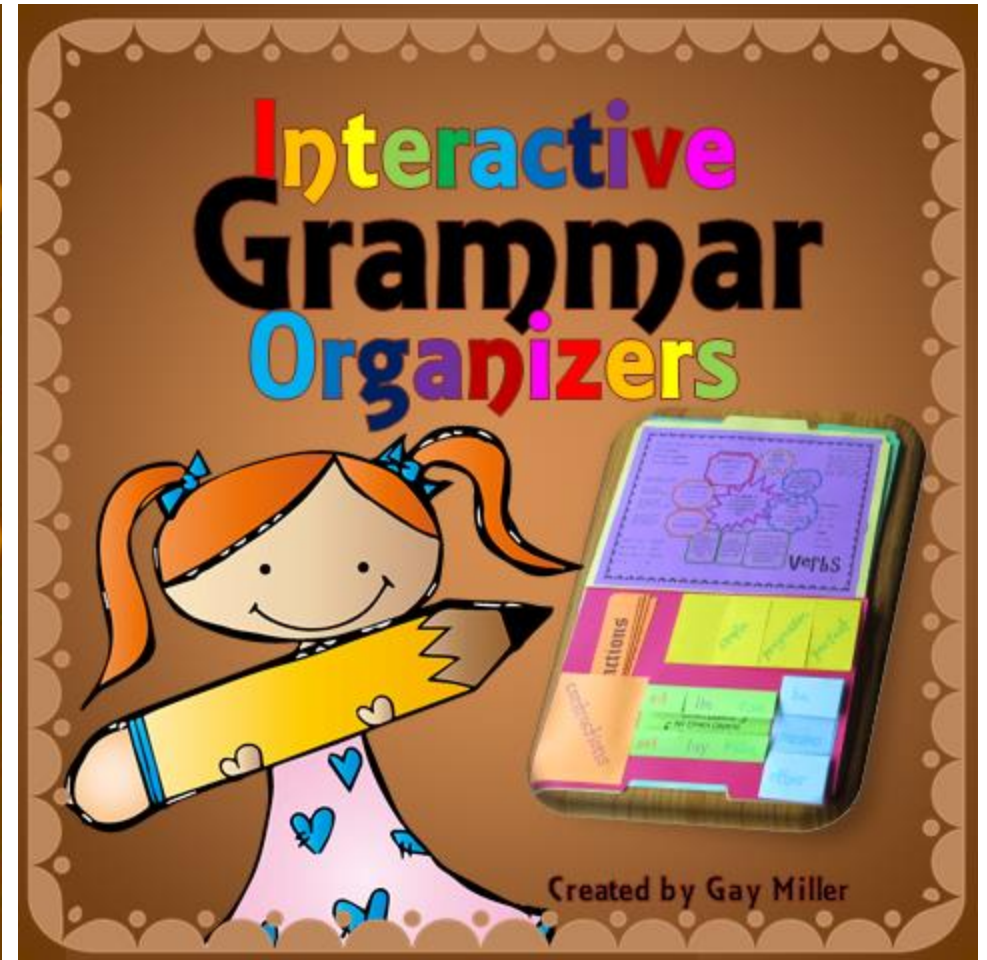
It is a clear night; it is probably cold outside.
