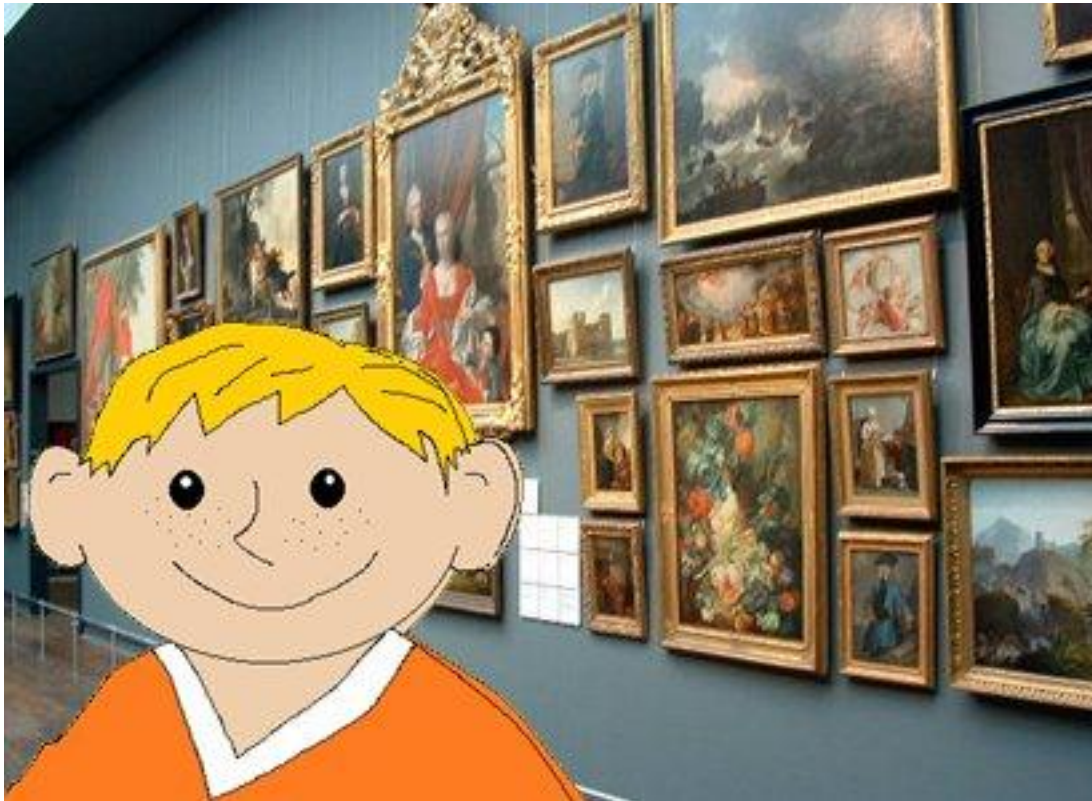

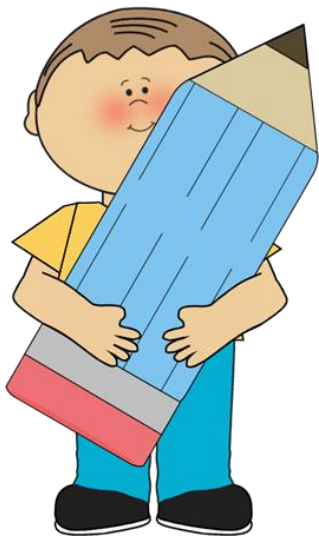
Chapter 5 Arthur's Good Idea
