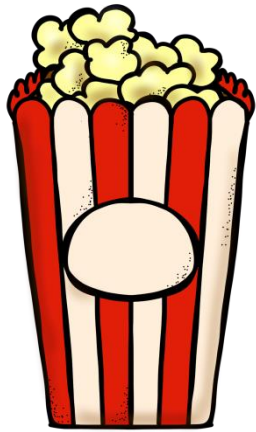


A noun is the part of speech that names a person, place, thing, or idea. In sentences, nouns generally function as subjects or as objects.

A **common noun** names any person, place, thing, or idea. Common nouns are often preceded by a, an or the.

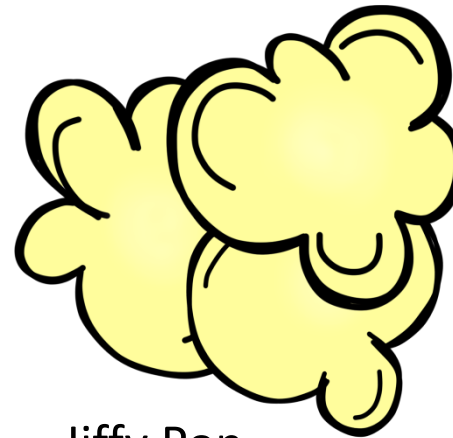

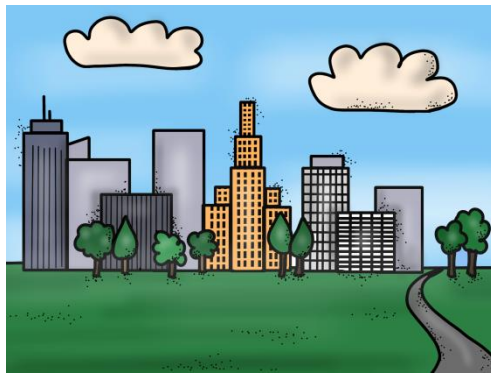
A **proper noun** names a particular person, place or thing. Proper nouns begin with capital letters

Babe Ruth



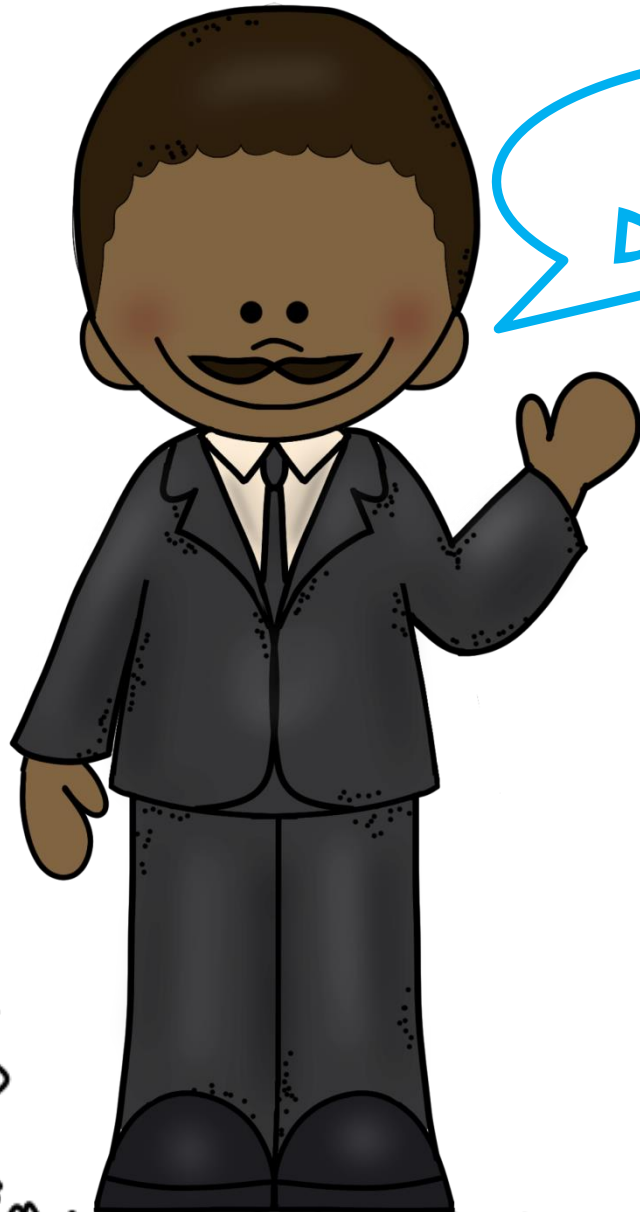

Abstract nouns refer to an idea, state, or quality.

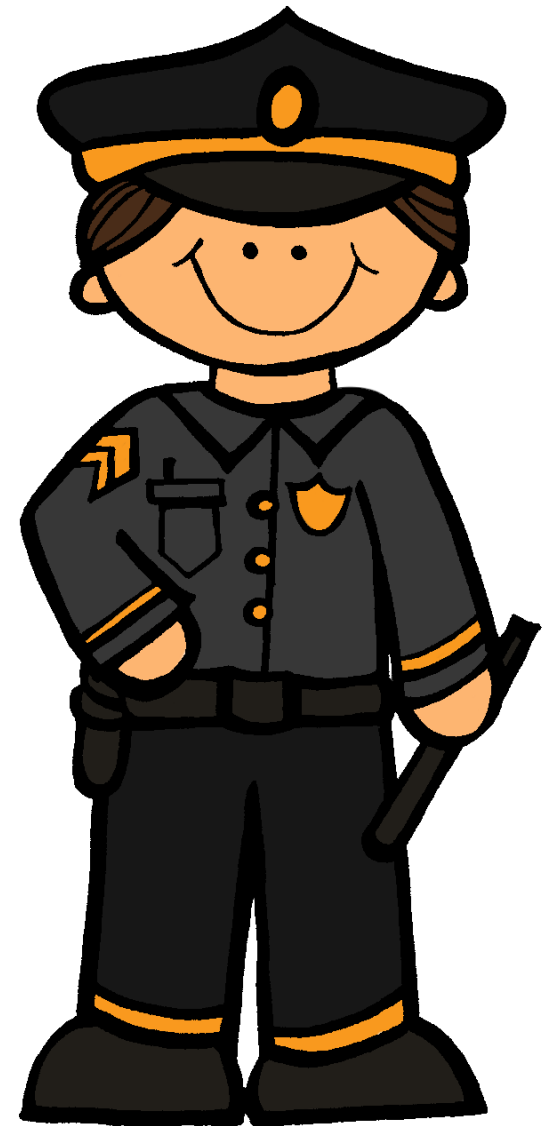
Concrete nouns name things you can see, taste, smell, hear, or touch.



Plural nouns name more than one person, place, or thing.

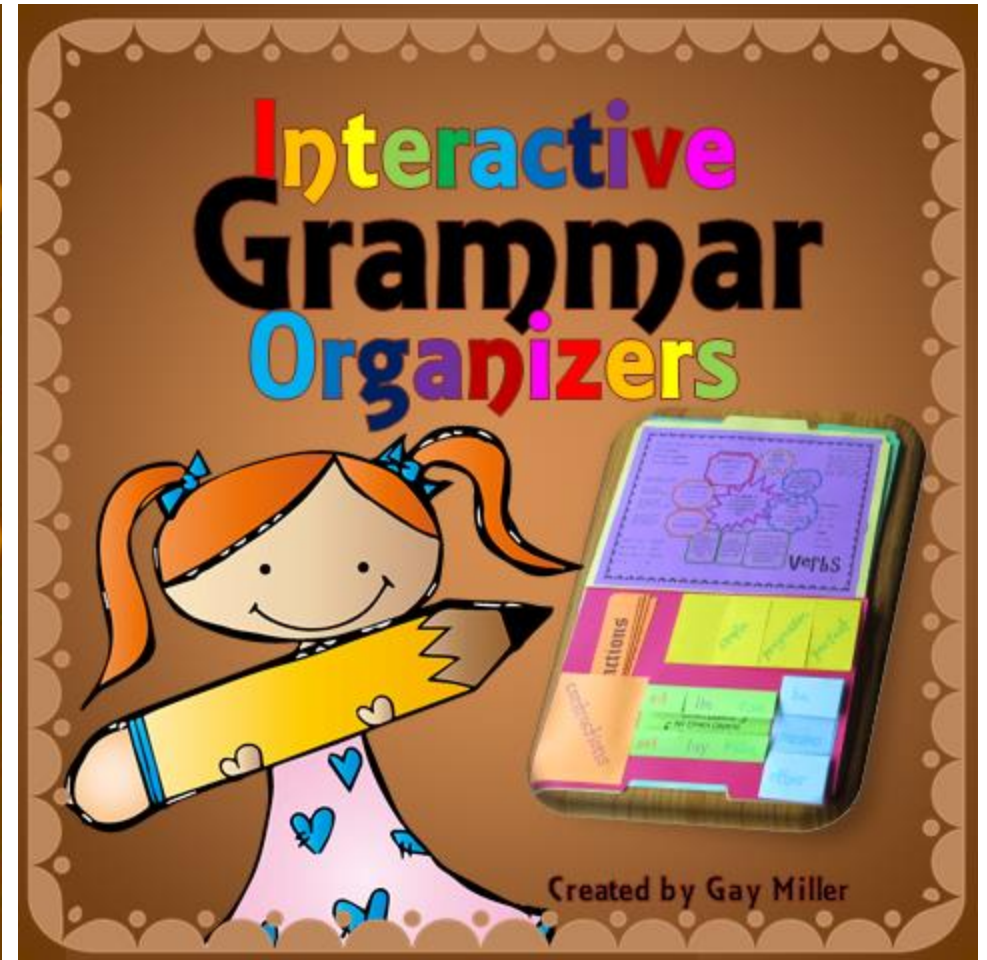
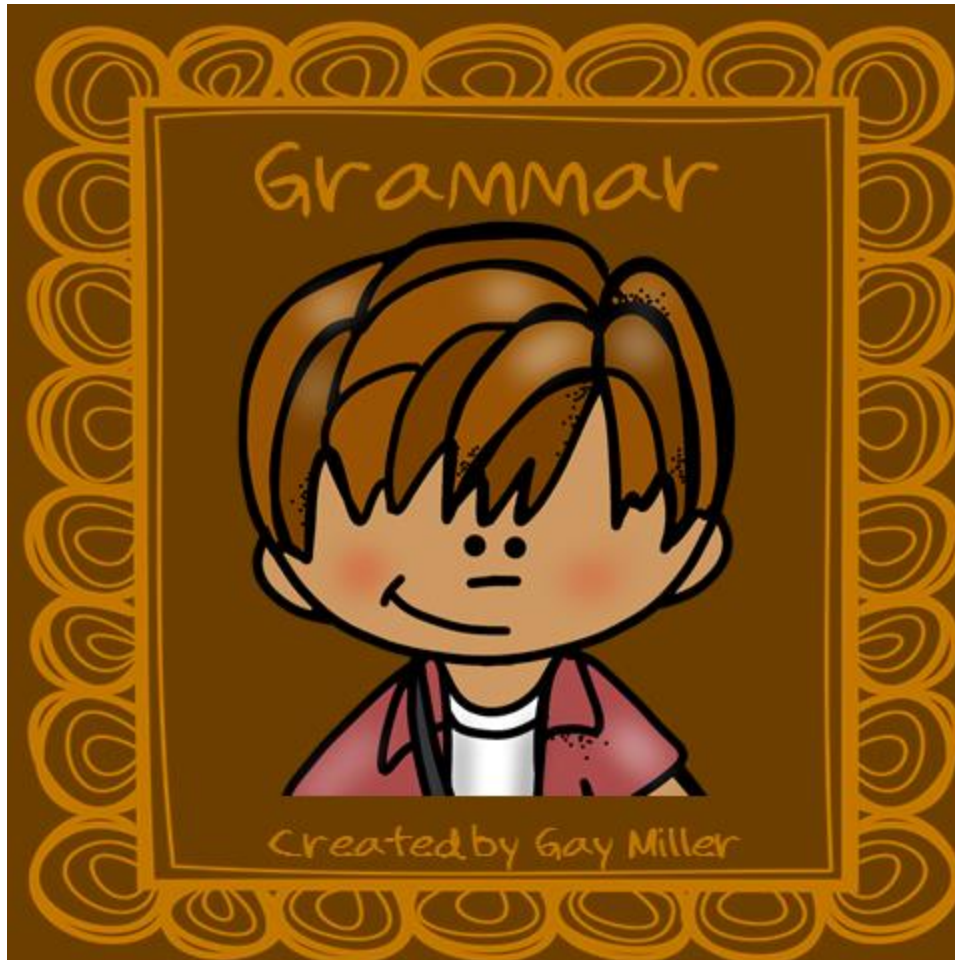


Singular nouns name one person, place, or thing.
