A noun is the part of speech that names a person, place, thing, or idea. In sentences, nouns generally function subjects or as objects.

A common noun names any person, place, thing, or idea. Common nouns are often preceded by a, an or the.




A proper noun names a particular person, place or thing. Proper nouns begin with capital letters

Plural nouns name more than one person, place, or thing.





Singular nouns name one person, place, or thing.
