Instructions

Two activities are included.

Activity #1:

Print the cards on page 2 on cardstock. Laminate for repeated use. Cut the cards apart.


Students read the sentences on the cards. They then sort the cards into two piles depending on the voice the sentence is written: "Active" or "Passive" voice. Using two containers for the sorted piles will help many students remember which pile is which. Solo cups work well for this. This photo shows the plastic containers from Extra gum. Any containers you have on hand will work for this.


An answer key for this activity is found on page 3 of this resource.
