



Which source would you use to find if empathetic should be used as an adjective or adverb? (dictionary)

Which source would you use to find where a country is located? (atlas)

Which source would you use to find statistics on the latest World Series games? (almanac)

Which source would you use to find farmers' planting dates? (almanac)

Which source would you use to find how to operate your new iPhone? (manual)

Which source would you use to know how to install a new program on your computer? (manual)

Which source would you use to find how to pronounce the word despicable? (dictionary)

Which source would you use to find the best way to travel on your next vacation? (atlas)

Which source would you use to information on the Middle Ages? (encyclopedia)




### Activity 3 – Task Cards


Students answer the questions on the task cards by writing which source: dictionary, thesaurus, manual, atlas, almanac, or encyclopedia would be used to locate the information needed.
