On the left sides of the booklet, students summarize the journey.

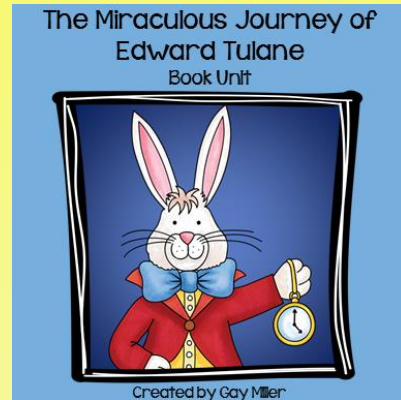
On the right sides of the booklet, students list character traits.
