Instructions for Making the Mini Book

Step 1

After cutting around the outside edge, fold the organizer in half "hotdog" fold with the words showing.



When turned on its back, your organizer should look like this.



Step 4
Fold the left and right sides to the middle. Your organizer should look like a fan.



Step 2

While the organizer is folded, cut off the dotted line between pages 1 and 4 and the cover page and page 5. Unfold the organizer after cutting.




Step 3Fold the organizer in half "hamburger" fold with the words showing.




Step 5
Refold on the "hotdog" fold from Step 1. At this stage your organizer should fold into a book.


